The collection of Pearl (Grieve) Bradwin (Mrs. Cecil Bradwin) was received shortly after her death. Mrs. Bradwin (ca. 1912-1978?) had been a teacher at Chilliwack Junior Secondary School.

The collection was initially accessioned as A.78.56.13 and .18-.24. It was formerly catalogued as Add.MSS. 250-255, but is now Add.MSS. 250.

A collection of the papers and photographs of the Grieve family, Add.MSS. 372, includes an album of photographs collected by Pearl Grieve in the 1920's or 1930's. *Another collection of Grieve family photographs is catalogued as P.COLL. 27. A collection of photographs by Cecil Bradwin is P.COLL. 28.*
