

McPhee, Marion (Sleightholm)

(Add.MSS. 649)

Marion McPhee arrived in Chilliwack with her family at the age of six in 1906. Prior to her marriage she was a teacher. She was involved in numerous charitable organizations and women's organizations, and was honored as Woman of the Year in 1964.

This collection contains various printed materials collected by Mrs. McPhee, and also the minutes of the Farm Forum Bees, a women's social club.

A recorded interview of Mrs. McPhee has been catalogued as Add.MSS. 403. Material on her nomination as Woman of the Year is contained in Add.MSS. 637. Photographs donated at the same time as this collection have been accessioned as P5295-P5297.
