**Administrative/Biographical History**

Reverend Charles Montgomery Tate was born in England in 1852 and came to North America when he was 18, sailing first to New York, travelling west to San Francisco, and eventually north to Nanaimo. He became a lay missionary in 1870 and was transferred to Chilliwack in 1874 where he stayed until 1880. He was then sent to Nanaimo, but was transferred back to Chilliwack in 1884 and eventually opened a school, Coqualeetza Home, in 1888. He died in 1933.
