BIOGRAPHICAL HISTORY

WILLIAM SAUNDERSON BARCLAY WAS BORN IN SOURIS, MANITOBA, IN 1899. HE WAS EDUCATED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA AND MANITOBA MEDICAL COLLEGE, RECEIVING HIS MEDICAL DEGREE IN 1924.

DR. BARCLAY SPECIALIZED IN THE TREATMENT OF TUBERCULOSIS. FROM 1941-1952 HE WAS SUPERINTENDENT OF COQUALEETZA INDIAN HOSPITAL AT SARDIS, BC. HE THEN BECAME DIRECTOR OF INDIAN AND NORTHERN HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, BASED IN VANCOUVER. HE RETIRED IN 1965 AND DIED IN 1984.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

THE FONDS CONSISTS OF A SCRAPBOOK PRIMARILY CONTAINING NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS AND CORRESPONDENCE REGARDING COQUALEETZA SANITORIUM. A PHOTOGRAPH ALBUM CONTAINS PHOTOS OF COQUALEETZA. NAMES OF THE PATIENTS AT THE HOSPITAL ARE INCLUDED.
