The Chilliwack Fish and Game Club was started sometime between 1900 - 1910 by a game warden named Mr. Cummings. A meeting for the purpose of organizing the Chilliwack Fish and Game Association was held on March 2, 1927. On October 24, 1936 the club registered itself under the Societies Act. The purpose of the club was stated in its constitution: to promote rod and gun contests, to protect fish and game in the district, and to promote ideas to better fishing and hunting conditions.
