### **Creative in Quarantine call for Submissions**

**Exhibition Dates:** September 25, 2020 to December 23, 2020  
at the Chilliwack Museum and Archives

**Submission Period:** September 8 to September 18, 2020

**Artwork Pick-up:** January 4 to January 9, 2021

The Chilliwack Museum and Archives is seeking creative pieces to display in our community art show from September 25, 2020 to December 23, 2020. This year's theme, "Creative in Quarantine" focuses on the works that our community created at home during the COVID-19 economic shutdown.

There is no specification on what can be submitted and no age requirement! We want to see and show what you created during quarantine! All members of the Chilliwack Community are welcome to submit their pieces. Work must be submitted to the Chilliwack Museum by September 18, 2020 at 4:00pm.

The Exhibition will open on September 25, 2020 to coincide with Culture Days. Culture Days is a national celebration of arts, culture, and heritage. This year's theme, *Unexpected Intersections*, is meant to encourage creative and outside-the-box thinking to reveal new avenues of discovery, learning, and expression. What better time than to create a community exhibition that showcases the unexpected events of the last few months?

If you would like to showcase a piece in the upcoming exhibition, please complete the Submission form which can be picked up at the Chilliwack Museum and Archives, or printed online from [chilliwackmuseum.ca](http://chilliwackmuseum.ca). There is no limit to how many pieces can be submitted, however, the number of pieces displayed will be dependent on total submission and display space. Submissions may be of any medium including, but not limited to: crochet, textiles, polymer clay, ceramics, felting, paint, drawing etc. Wall mounted submissions must be submitted in a frame with a hanging mechanism. Submissions should be limited to 60 cm x 60cm. Oversized submissions will be considered on a case by case basis, and are dependent on available space. **All submissions must be labeled legibly with the full name of the artist.** The Chilliwack Museum and Archives reserves the right to refuse pieces based on size, medium, and content.

Pieces that are not chosen for display must be picked up immediately.
