INTRODUCTION

Clarence Casey Wells was born at Edenbank Farm, Sardis B.C. on 6 January 1902. He was the grandson of Sardis pioneer Allen Casey Wells and the son of Edwin Allen Wells. While a student at the University of British Columbia in 1919. Wells became interested in radio broadcasting. In 1927, he founded radio station C H W K, largely to promote sales of radios for his employer, a hardware store. In the 1950's he established an aerial photography business, and in the 1960's turned his attention to local history. Actively involved in the Chilliwack Valley Historical Society, he began collecting archival documents, and written and tape recorded reminiscences of Chilliwack pioneers. He published the Anthology of Valley History (a series of pamphlets), and organized guided historical tours of the area. He collected myths of the Sto:lo Indians, and studied the phonetics of the Halkomelem language. He was interested in genealogy, and co-established the Wells Family Society.

Wells was paid a small honorarium by the Chilliwack Valley Historical Society to act as its official Archivist. Following his death on November 11, 1976, his collection became Add. MSS. I of the Society's archival collection.

ARRANGEMENT OF THE COLLECTION

The largest portion of the collection was intended to form part of the Community History Research Library (CH/RL) and the Chilliwack Valley Archives (CVA). It was organized according to the Community History Mnemonic Code (CH/MC), an alphabetical filing sustem devised by Wells and modified slightly during its lifetime. A record of tape recordings, the Reel Record (RR) was also maintained by Wells and organized according to the CH/MC. A collection on Linguistics and Phonetics was organized by its own coding system. Some business and accession records of the Chilliwack Valley Historical Society (CVHS) were found in the collection. Some of Wells' household and personal records (WH) were organized according to the ABCode system which he devised. A large collection of maps of the Chilliwack area are included. Also included were the notebooks of an early settler, possibly Nils Nilsson, and some papers of Oliver Wells pertaining to Edenbank Farm and to B.C. Indians.

The first accession of the Casey Wells papers was donated by his widow, Alice Wells in June 1977. Approximately two-thirds of it, Files 1-558, was inventoried and arranged into 18 subject categories by Marianne Wood and other summer students employed by the Society in 1977. The remainder, some of it fragmentary in character, was left in the original looseleaf binders. In November 1986, these papers were inventoried, retaining Wells' original order as much as possible, by Jim Bowman, as Files 559-684.

On Febuary 28, 1988, an additional 2 meters of Casey Wells' papers mostly pertaining to his business affairs and genealogical interests, was donated by his daughter, Dolly Young of Chilliwack. These papers were arranged and described by Mark Adams and Jim Bowman in May-June 1989, as Files 685-883.
