Jonathan Wood Galloway was born at Sutton-on-Hull, England, on January 4, 1856. He became a Methodist missionary, although he was never ordained, and taught school at Coqualeetza Institute in the 1890's. He was also a butcher by trade, and operated a butcher shop in Chilliwack until 1906. He then moved the business to Fraser Mills, but his home remained at Chilliwack. Mr. Galloway was also appointed a Justice of the Peace in 1899.

On January 18, 1899, Mr. Galloway married Willena "Lena" Reece, the daughter of Chilliwack's pioneer Jonathan Reece. Children of this union were:

The Galloway family collection includes Mr. Galloway's notebooks, ca. 1894- ca. 1896, containing a vocabulary of the Halkomelem language, and hymns translated into Halkomelem. The account book of Mr. Galloway's butcher shop 1898- 1903) has been used as a scrapbook (1925-1954). Other scrapbooks and historical items were collected by Mrs. J. W. Galloway, and by Mrs. Frances M. Owen.
