Administrative/Biographical History

The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District was formed in 1985 for the purpose of editing and publishing a book on the history of their area. With the aid of two grants from the New Horizons Administration of Health and Welfare Canada, they succeeded in the production and sale of one thousand copies of "In the Shadow of Mt. Cheam". Their purpose fulfilled, they met for the last time in December 1989 and disbanded.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of drafts of articles and original photographs used in the book "In the Shadow of Mt. Cheam". Also included are the group's business correspondence, and some original archival documents, essays, and photographs pertaining to the Rosedale area but not used in the book.

On October 24, 1985 The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District came together for their first official meeting, with one purpose. That purpose was to publish a historical account of the region containing the communities of Camp River, Rosedale, Popcum and Cheam View, in the eastern end of the Chilliwack Valley in British Columbia. The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District began chronicling this history before 1985 but it was really after the 75th anniversary of the founding of the Rosedale Athletic Club that gave their group renewed energy.

Two grants from New Horizons Administration of the Department of Health and Welfare, Canada were given to The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District. With renewed energy and funding they produced their book "In the Shadow of Mt. Cheam" in 1988. One thousand of the books were printed and sold after which the bank balance of the organization was donated to community works in the surrounding area.

Their purpose fulfilled, The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale met for the last time on December 14, 1989 and moved to disband. A handful of seniors with some government funding had managed to fulfill their goal, with the publication of their book the history of their region would be safe.

For the most part, the records of The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District revolve around their published book "In the Shadow of Mt. Cheam". Photographs used in the book as well as rough copies, rough and final drafts of the stories in the book comprise a great deal of this collection(Note some stories or photos found in the book will not be present in this collection as some have been returned.)

Also in this collection are photos and stories of the Rosedale District not used in the book, correspondence, and a few articles of historical significance. The correspondence in this collection includes letters from writers of the book, businesses, and various government agencies(mostly dealing with the research and funding of the book).

So in summary the material in the collection is either used in the book "In the Shadow of Mt. Cheam" or is somehow related to the book or the organization Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District.

This collection was donated by Fred Bryant, Laurie Anderson, and Mary Person on behalf of The Heritage Preservers of Rosedale and District on the following dates; July 6, 1989(Acc. No. 989.52), July 12, 1989(Acc. No. 989.59), August 29, 1989(Acc. No. 989.70), and September 8, 1989(Acc. No. 989.80).
