The History of Club 28.

After 1½ years as Sardis Memorial I.O.D.E., Club 28 was formed on February 8, 1951 as a local service and social group for young mothers. Many of its members were new to the area due to relocating after the war. They organized as a service to benefit the community. They limited their numbers to 28 so they could meet in each others homes.

Their main project was helping the Coqualeetza Hospital in Sardis, but other funds were also raised and donated to Sunshine Drive, the Red Cross and Valley Haven. The money raised came from three main fund raisers; a Halloween tea, a garden party and the Hop Yard Rummage sale.

After 28 years of service members of Club 28 received a special award on behalf of their efforts.
